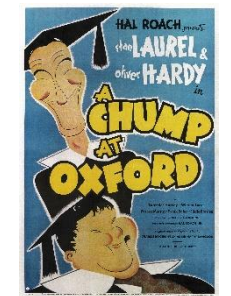
Friday 8th September 2017 – 22:00
