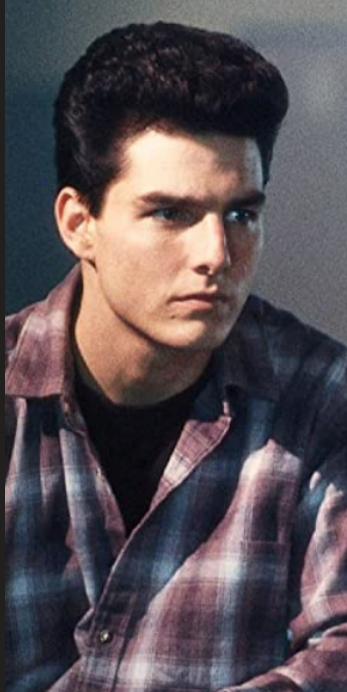

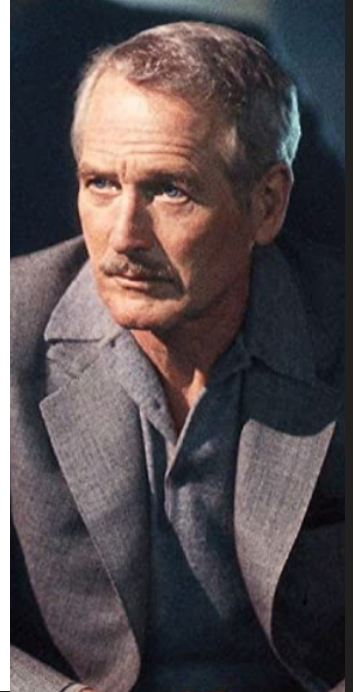


The Colour of Money

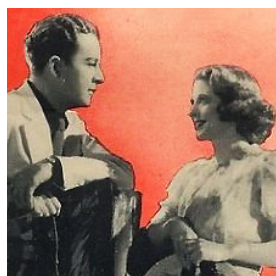

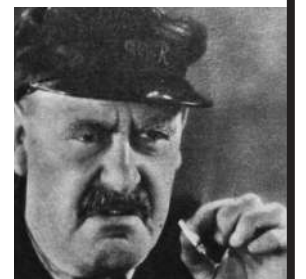
