every Sunday.

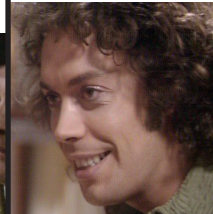

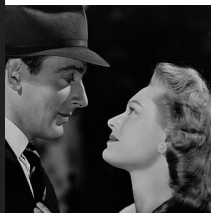


Saturday 27th April 19 15:10 The Villain (1979)
