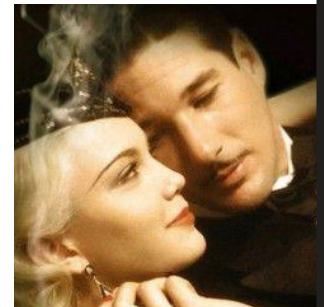
### Saturday 15th June 16:20 **The Ghost of St Michael's (1941)**
