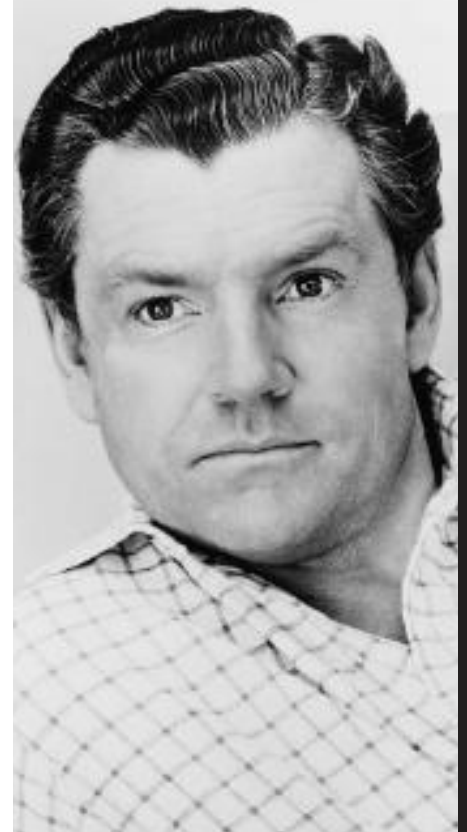

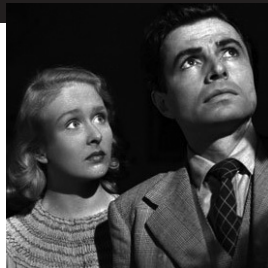
## **Kenneth More Day on Talking Pictures TV**

On the anniversary of his death on July 12, 1982, we celebrate the life of **Kenneth More** with a day of films and interviews. An accomplished stage and film actor, his career spanned the decades from the 1930s to the 1980s, and he was a frequent screen presence in the 1950s, usually portraying characters who were likeable, reliable and quintessentially English. He was nominated for a BAFTA on four occasions and awarded a CBE in 1970. Today we present: **Our Girl Friday** (1953) at 06:10; **Man In The Moon** (1960) at 07:40; at 09:40 an interview with **Anneke Wills** who appeared with More in **Some People** (1962) which follows at 10:35. **Brandy for the Parson** (1951) is at 12:25 and at 14:30 Part 1 of **Remembering Kenneth More** will air, followed by **North West Frontier** (1959) at 14:50 and then an interview at 17:30 with actress **Angela Douglas**, who was More's wife from 1968 until his death. The film that made him a star, **Genevieve** (1953), shows at 18:30 followed by Part 2 of **Remembering Kenneth More** at 20:15. **The Comedy Man** (1964) is at 21:30 followed by **Loss of Innocence** (1961) at 23:20, based on, and also known as, **The Greengage Summer**, a novel by Rumer Godden, which tells the story of a young girl's awakening to adulthood and love while on holiday in France, with a young **Susannah York** in her first leading role.

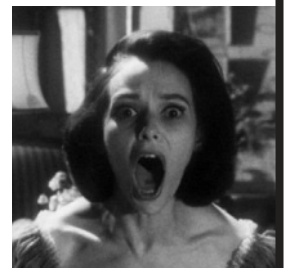

## **ROOMS new series on Talking Pictures TV**

Not seen on British TV since its original run in 1974, **Rooms** was directed by John Russell from 1974-1977 as well as Brian Farnham, among others. Fay Weldon, Deborah Mortimer, Paula Milne and James Doran were just some of the many writers who worked on the scripts. Each week a two part story focussed on different tenants of 35 Mafeking Terrace, an old London house which has been converted into bed-sits. Many tenants come and go; some are on their way to a more settled life; others will spend their lives just passing through. The landlords live in the basement; they are the only thread which links those who pass through the house.

### **Episode 1: Jan & Tony Part 1 and Episode 2: Jan & Tony Part 2**

Jan is a student who is working in a restaurant during her vacation; she is curious about fellow tenant Tony, and discovers that he is AWOL from the army. She feels compelled to do something about it.
