Thurs 10th Oct 19 22:00

The Family Way (1966)

Drama, directed by: Roy & John Boulting. Stars Hayley Mills, Hywel Bennett, John Mills & Marjorie Rhodes. The troubles of two young newlyweds whose marriage has yet to be consummated.

We Serve (1942)

Training film for officers of the ATS, directed by Carol Reed and featuring Celia Johnson, Ann Todd, Joyce Carey and Peggy Ashcroft.

Drama, directed by Alan Cooke. Starring: Terence Stamp, Robert Vaughn & Nigel Davenport. Since his birth John Soames has been in a coma & is brought to life in a neurological clinic.
