Director: Terence Fisher. Stars: Derek Bond, Susan Shaw, Patrick Holt, Carol Marsh.

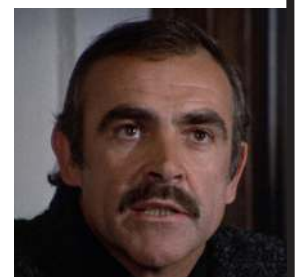
