

One Step Beyond on Talking Pictures TV

Broadcast from January 1959 to July 1961, One Step Beyond was hosted and directed by John Newland and, like The Twilight Zone, which began broadcasting nine months later, it focussed on other-wordly phenomena. Among its stories, the series dealt with premonition of death: The Lincoln Assassination; disaster: Tidal Wave; astral projection: The Long Call; ghosts: The Death Waltz and coincidence: Reunion. Among those who appeared were: Paula Raymond, Elizabeth Montgomery, Jocelyn Brando, Joan Fontaine, Warren Beatty, Charles Bronson, Jack Lord, Christopher Lee, Patrick Macnee, André Morell, Donald Pleasence, William Shatner and Peter Wyngarde.

The series will be airing on Tuesdays at 6pm from May 11th.


Sherlock Holmes on Talking Pictures TV

The first television adaptation of Doyle's stories, Sherlock Holmes first aired in 1954, starring Ronald Howard as Holmes and H. Marion Crawford as Watson. Archie Duncan appeared as Inspector Lestrade. The series was filmed at Epinay-sur-Seine and Seine-Saint-Denis in France and in London. Actors who appeared in the series included: Michael Gough, Grégoire Aslan, Paulette Goddard and Richard O'Sullivan. Airs at 6pm on Wednesdays from May 12th.

Horror. Director: Gary Sherman. Stars: Donald Pleasence, Christopher Lee. Two London students find themselves involved in the case of a missing man.














Saturday 15th May 2:05pm The Land that Time Forgot (1975)
