EDWARD WOODWARD hosts this fascinating factual entertainment programme made in 1991, which combines drama, documentary and storytelling to present the facts behind a series of true murder mysteries.

Episode 1 - Mrs Bravo Regrets Et Al - No Smoke Without Fire - Jewel And The Magpie.

Three short stories centred around real life murder stories. An ambitious barrister had suffered a lingering and agonising death by poison. Was it suicide, accidental death or murder? An elderly widow aged seventy-nine is viciously murdered, but was the seventeen year old boy who confessed really guilty? 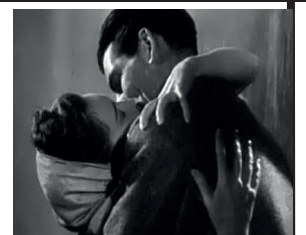
**Tuesday 8th November 8.20am

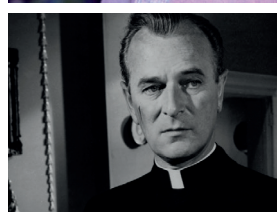
Friday 11th November 10.05am The Spanish Gardener (1956)

An exclusive documentary commemorating the end of WWI. Presented by war historian Alan Forbes who visits the battlefields Flanders and the Somme.



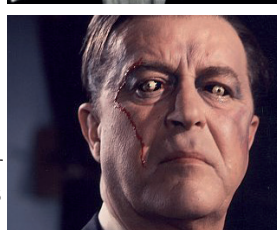
Friday 11th November 5.50pm Ghost and Mrs. Muir (1947)

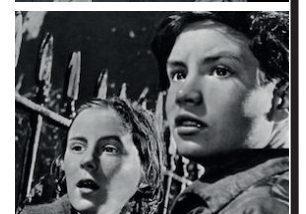
Sunday 13th November 1.40pm Albert R.N. (1953)
