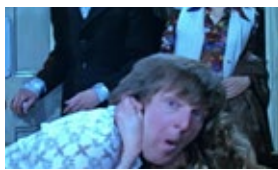

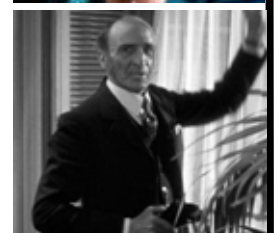

Maigret (2002) Maigret and the Minister. Stars Bruno Cremer. A government minister asks Maigret for help after falling victim to dirty tricks. [S]



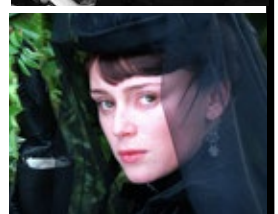
Wednesday 6th March 8.40am

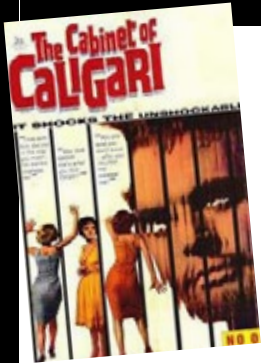

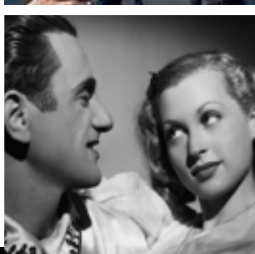
Thursday 7th March 8pm

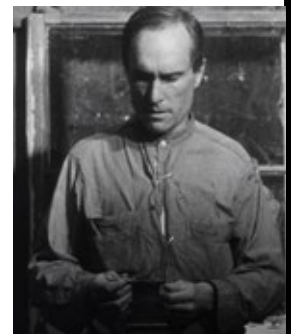
Sunday 10th March 12.20pm **Rawhide (1951)**
