Directed by Laurence Stewart Stars: Don Durant A woman claims to be Johnny Ringo's wife



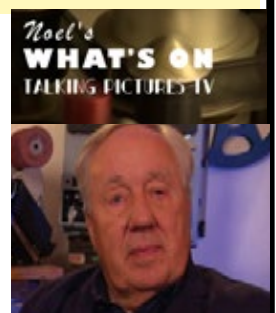

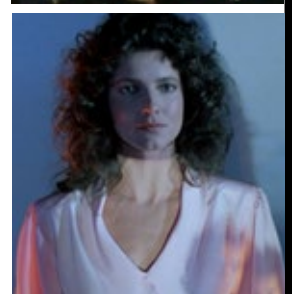
