Comedy. Directed by Mario Soldati. Stars Jean Kent, Robert Beatty. A gangster learns that a bank clerk is his exact double.

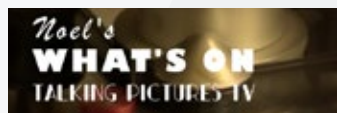
