Film star Richard Todd recalls dropping through the sky, as a paratrooper, on Pegasus Bridge, a target that it was vital for the British to capture and hold this landmark.

Directed by Robert Gist and starring Joan Crawford. Della, a reclusive, wealthy matriarch of Royal Bay, watches over the affluent coastal town.



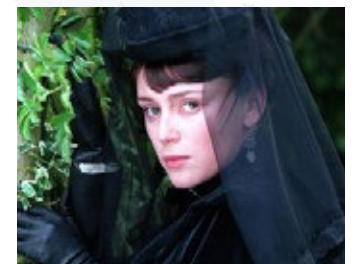
Tokyo Joe (1949)
