### (NEW) PLAN 9 FROM OUTER SPACE- Sat 22nd June at 1pm

Classic cult Sci-Fi. Famously written, directed and produced by Ed Wood, the film was shot in black-and-white in November 1956 (under the shooting title Grave Robbers from Outer Space) and went into general release in April 1959. Starring Gregory Walcott, Tom Keene, Bela Lugosi, Maila Nurmi & Mona McKinnon.

The film tells the story of extraterrestrials who seek to stop humanity from creating a doomsday weapon that could destroy the universe. The aliens implement "Plan 9", a scheme to resurrect the Earth's dead. By causing chaos, the aliens hope the crisis will force humanity to listen to them; otherwise, the aliens will destroy mankind with armies of undead.
