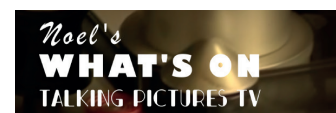

The classic game show hosted by Michael Parkinson. Celebrity guests Keith Barron, Emma Thompson, Keith Chegwin. [S]

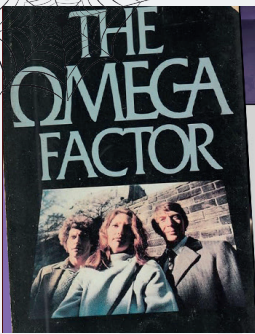
**The Sea Shall Not Have Them** (1954) **Wed 6th May at 9.10pm**

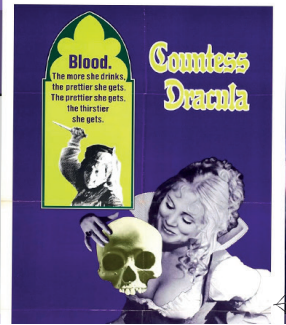
