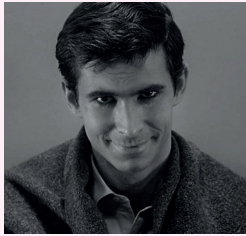


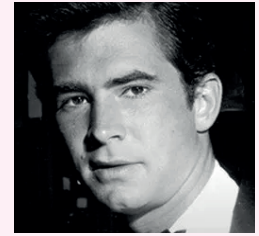
WHAT'S ON TALKING PICTURES TV?

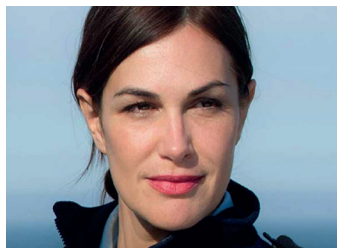
