Drama. Directed by Nicholas Ray. Stars Humphrey Bogart. A screenwriter is accused of murder his neighbour comes to his rescue. [S]

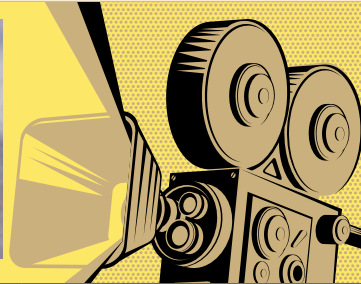
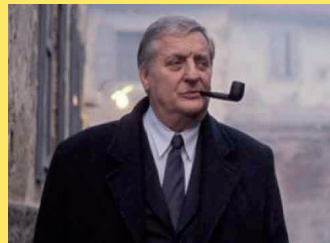
Four Star Playhouse: The House Always Wins (1955)

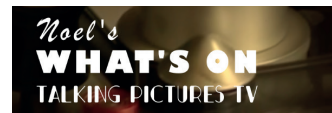


The Mummy (1959) **Mon 18th May at 10.20pm**

Thriller. Directed by John Guillermin. Stars John Bentley. A crime novelist, jealous over his secretary's affection for his brother, decides to murder her. [S]

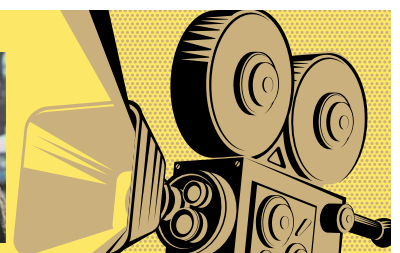
