The Atomic Submarine

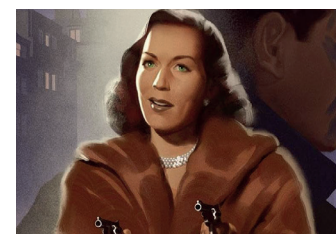

Drama. Director: Francis Searle. Stars Hy Hazell. A private detective hires an actress to go undercover in the home of a wealthy woman. [S]



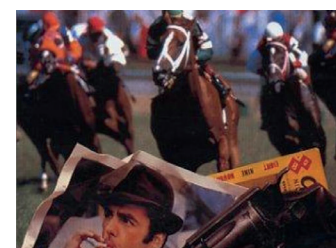
Celine Dion: A Star is Born (2024) **Tues 26th May at 4pm**

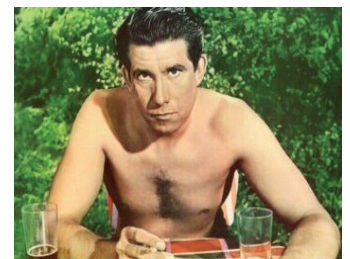
X The Unknown (1956) **Fri 29th May at 2.45pm**

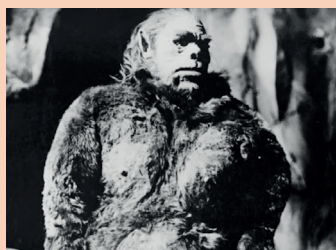

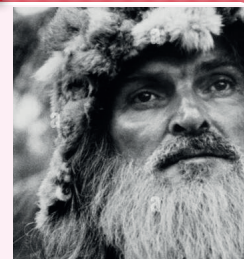
